On 31st August 2017 KingsCare League of Friends became a CIO (Charitable Incorporated Organisation) No 1174450.

Nothing has changed apart from the legal status of KingsCare League of Friends. Our ways of working, our activities, our aims and our future plans remain the same.

Over the past year we have been working to make the transition from the charity to the CIO. Once completed the original charity will be closed down. This will happen as soon as possible after our Annual General Meeting on Monday 10th September.
